- Provides a coherent methodology to enable a city to change its water system from today's state into a better condition in the future.
- The manual guides all stakeholder groups at three different levels, strategic in which visions are set, tactical, enabling a wide variety of options to be evaluated by the stakeholders using the vehicle of the Learning Alliance, and operational when the implementation tools are used.
- The manual is new in the SWITCH project but has been based on the accumulated knowledge gained in a range of city meetings and conferences.
- Transitioning is a new and developing approach. This is the first time that all of the elements of change from visioning to implementation have been set down in one manual.
- The manual calls on a wide range of case studies from both with and outside SWITCH and uses four SWITCH cities for its backbone.
